

Fred Dillingham, Livingston County Commissioner, was introduced and reported on a hearing to be held on April 15, to discuss the soil sedimentation ordinance. A new realestate tax plan is being planed, a meeting will be held to discuss this plan.

The 75-76 budget was presented by Sonja Klein and L.D. Dickerson. Motion by George Robb, seconded by Gordon Carbary that the Township raise one mil of property tax in 1976. Motion carried. Motion by Gordon Carbary, seconded by George Robb to raise the Supervisors salary \$500. Motion carried. An expense item of \$350 for an audit was added to the budget. Motion by George Robb, seconded by Gordon Carbary to accept the budget, as amended, Motion carried.

Motion by Victor Miller, seconded by George Robb that the Township Board be allowed to raise and spend Township monies as they see fit. Motion carried. Motion by Gordon Carbary, seconded by George Robb to adjourn. Motion carried.

Motion by Mel Voss seconded by Sonja Klein to purchase a minute book for the Zoning Board and the Township Board also an ordinance book. The books to be loose leaf type with artificial leather covers.

Cemetery care was discussed. Floyd Lang was present and entered a bid for the care of the cemeteries as follows, Benjiman and the hall grounds-\$25. Cougran \$30. and \$3. for all hand labor. The Township to furnish the mower. Mike Mc Kinna entered a bid of \$25. for the Cougran \$35. for the Benjiman with all hand labor at \$3. per hour with all equipment furnished. Motion by Harry Kreeger seconded by Sonja Klein to award the work in the Benjiman and Cougran cemeteries to Mike McKinna. Motion carried. Work in the Antrim-Conway cemetery to be done by the Lewis Bbothers and in the Miller by Roy Horton. Dick Carbury is taking the dog cences in Conway Township

Roads were discussed. Motion by Sonja Klein seconded by Mel Voss to invite the property owners on the east end of Sober Road and a Representative from the Road Commission to the next meeting to discuss future plans for Sober road. Motion carried.

Zoning problems were discussed. There are several junk cars at the William Vogt Jr. residence on Allen Rd. The trailer on the Ayotte has not been removed as ordered by District Court order. Edward Heinrich has expanded his business at his farm. Motion by Sonja Klein seconded by Harry Kreeger to have letters sent by the Clerk to Mr. Vogt and Mrs. Ayotte and have the Zoning Administrator contact Mr. Heinrich to discuss the need for a special use permit. Supervisor Kingsley reported that the Board of Health had not issued a septic tank permit as yet. Legal Considerations were discussed. Sober road improvement was discussed with the several landowners on Sober road. Road Commission representatives discussed the many of a satisfactory road rebuilding program. The cost would be about \$30,000. Drainage is one of the major problems, landowners will contact Drain Commissioner to request a study of the problem. Only minor repair work is secured for 1975.

Mike McKenna was present to discuss cemetery care. The Board expressed dissatisfaction in the care of the cemeteries. Mr. McKenna agreed to spend more time at mowing in the future. Motion by Sonja Klein seconded by L.D. Dickerson to pay bills as presented. Motion carried. Fred Dillingham reported that a new Equalization Director has been hired for Livingston County. County Road Commission to discuss Township roads. Ray Slanker was present and presented a petition that would put the Court House remodeling project on the ballot at the next election. Progress on the Fire Hall building program was reported by the Supervisor. Motion by Klein seconded by Kreeger to pay bills as presented. Motion carried. NOVEMBER 19, 1975


TIME : 8 P.M.
